RWSI took the lead in conducting adverse weather-Monsoon op ground training for pilots as required vide DGCA Operation Circular 9 of 2010. The Course which was conducted on 09 June 2011 at Hotel Four Seasons, Juhu Mumbai . The weather capsule was intended to refresh the knowledge of pilots on weather during the monsoon phase, its usage and importance with regards to aviation especially to flight safety. The course was combined with three sessions on Avoidance of CFIT (Operation Circular 1 of 2009 on CFIT).

Most of the CFIT helicopter accidents that have occurred were attributed to weather and lack of realistic weather picture for low altitude flying. Weather was a factor in 9 of the 10 CFIT accidents. In some cases the pilot did not have the benefit of weather forecast as they took off from locations that did not have weather station or weather forecast facilities. So when pilots encountered IMC, in an attempt to maintain or regain visual contact with the ground, they descended and the helicopter struck the ground in an area of low cloud and dense ground fog.

The courses were conducted by Mr. Ravi Shankar Ex Director IMD, Capt R S Dangi Manager Safety UHPL and Capt Sanjay Mittal Chief Pilot UHPL under the guidance of Capt Uday Gelli President RWSI (Western Region). On completion of the course, a certificate of completion was handed over to each of the participant. The Course was attended by 28 pilots and the list is placed below:-

So when pilots encountered IMC, in an attempt to maintain or regain visual contact with the ground, they descended and the helicopter struck the ground in an area of low cloud and dense ground fog.
